"The fieldwork for this survey was carried out between August and December 1987 by myself and Rona Thomson, both members of Strathkelvin Local Studies Project. Since 1983 the Local Studies Project had been working, in conjunction with Library staff, collating and making available to the public, a growing body of information on Strathkelvin's Local History. Project members were already listing Archival Collections, indexing the local newspaper and building up an oral archive, and in 1987 it was decided that surveying local graveyards would be added to this on-going process.

Baldernock was chosen because it was an old graveyard, existing long before the present church which was built in 1795, and because the Baldernock area of Strathkelvin had not had much work done on it. The study of the local graveyard would tell much about the parish and its people.

There is the gravestone of Alexander Dunlop (B60) who took part in passing the Reform Bill in the mid 19th Century. There is also the stone of Rev. John Pollock who led out his congregation at the Disruption of 1843 and formed the Free Kirk Congregation (C176). There are also stones for many generations of the same family, such as the Bowies of Whitefauld Farm who are spelt Bovie on their earliest stones (B78).

In carrying out this survey, we followed the method outlined in "How to record Scottish Graveyards" by Betty Willsher. The idea was to create as complete a record of every stone as possible. Therefore an individual monument record sheet was filled out for every stone. These give details of any inscriptions and decoration. On the second page of the record sheets, the inscription is written out in full (with any spelling mistakes) as it appears on the stone. Also there is a space for a photograph of the stone.

It will be noted that at the beginning of each monument sheet there is a number. This is to show what part of the graveyard the stone stands in. Section A is the furthest south part of the graveyard; Section B is to the west of the Church; Section C is immediately south of the church; Section D is east of the Church; Section E is to the north of the Church and Section F is the new extension across the road from the Church.

After filling out these record sheets, six plans were produced showing the location of the stones in the six sections. However, before filling out the sheets, many of the stones had to be cleaned in order to make their inscriptions legible. Also, as there were so many flat stones in the graveyard and many had sunk underneath the turf over the years, these had to be dug out in all weather conditions. This was the labour intensive part of the survey. Cleaning these stones had to be done carefully, so as not to damage the fragile sandstone. Therefore, we often used toothpicks to get all the moss out of the inscriptions. It was always a delight to uncover stones which had been hidden under the turf as they were often the oldest ones, the covering of turf ensuring that they are well preserved.

The final process in the survey was the photographing of the stones; unfortunately it proved too costly to photograph every stone so only representative ones were eventually photographed.

It is hoped that this survey will not be an end in itself, but will prove useful to anyone

carrying out further research into Baldernock. Initially we had planned to carry out further research ourselves, but unfortunately, we do not have time to do this due to the short-term nature of the Local Studies Project. But the fact that this survey now exists, means that it is a useful source of information for future Local Historians, Genealogists, Demographers and Archaeologists to make use of.

Just as importantly, copies of the survey will be held in Strathkelvin Libraries in order to make the information available to the local population. A copy of the survey will also be kept at Baldernock Church, so that anyone tracing relatives or ancestors can make use of it. Judging by the amount of people we met whilst at the graveyard, this will be well used.

The survey itself was very interesting and enjoyable to carry out (though cold, wet and muddy at times!) and I hope that it will become a useful part of the growing amount of information on the history of Strathkelvin gathered by both Local Studies and Library staff.”
