**Better broadband for Baldernock** – Update on our Community Fibre Partnership 14 November 2023. Another 66 addresses in Baldernock can now order a full fibre service from their preferred internet service provider, bringing the total to 150 those householders that can now connect to the upgraded network. The most recent list includes around half of households in Croft Road, with the other half expected to 'go live' soon. Ongoing work by Openreach engineers should bring full fibre broadband to all 430 homes and businesses in our Community Fibre Partnership by the end of the year.
